These leotards are a special order and anyone purchasing them will wear them for the first time at their Mini Olympics. These leotards **MUST** be ordered in advance. The cost is \$40 per leotard for orders received by March 20. Order forms are available at the Front Desk. Your order with payment is due by Saturday, March 20, in order to guarantee delivery by the Mini Olympics. We will also be having a Boy's T-Shirt available for our male students. Order forms for the t-shirt will be available at the of April. Purchase of the leotard and/or the t-shirt are optional.



If you do not pre-order the leotard by March 20, a limited number will be available for purchase (at \$45) the week prior to the Mini-Olympics. However, not all sizes and fabrics may be available. To guarantee your size and fabric, your order must be received by March 20.

### Snow Days

Due to the crazy weather in February, ENA was closed on February 10, 25 and 26 due to snow. Since we were closed for the entire day, we have extended our current session one week for students in Wednesday, Thursday and Friday classes. You do **NOT** need to do a make-up for these closings.

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## Session 4 Bills



Bills for Session 4 will be mailed to all current ENA students the week of March 15. These students have until their last class of Session 3 to pay for Session 4 in order to guarantee their spot. All unpaid spots will be open to our Waiting Lists and new students the day after their last class of Session 3. Payment may be made over the phone with a credit card. *Please note: Since all classes end the week of June 21, the number of weeks in Session 4 varies for each day. Bills will reflect the number of weeks in Session 4 for each student's class. You must be registered in Session 4 to participate in the Mini-Olympics. Also — The last week of class in Session 4 —the week of June 21— is our annual “Bring-A-Friend” week where you can bring a friend to your gymnastics class. Forms for friends will be available in late May.*

## Fall Classes



It's not too early to start thinking about the fall. Registration for our Fall Programs will begin on May 3 for CURRENT ENA students and May 10 for all others. At that time, you can place a deposit for a class on the day and time that fits your needs. A schedule of fall classes will be distributed in April. Classes fill quickly, so start thinking now about when to schedule your child's gymnastics class in the fall. *Current students who sign up for a fall 2010 class and leave a deposit BEFORE MAY 10, will receive a 10 percent discount on their Session 1 class tuition. Even if you are in a class now, you must register AGAIN for the fall. You are NOT automatically signed up!!!!!!*

## NO JEWELRY PLEASE!!!!!!!



PLEASE DO NOT SEND YOUR CHILD TO CLASS WITH JEWELRY. Not only is it not safe for your child to be wearing it while doing gymnastics, it can get lost. All found jewelry is kept at the Front Desk.

## Make Up Classes

Please make every effort to have your child attend their regular scheduled class each week. It is important in developing their gymnastics skills that they be with their same class each week. Our make-up policy is posted in our Lobby. You can only schedule a make-up AFTER you miss a class. Due to class size restrictions, make-ups are only available in certain classes. Once a make-up is scheduled, it is considered taken. Make-ups cannot be cancelled or changed. To be fair to all, we must limit make-ups to two (2) per student during each session.

## Please Pull Back Your Hair!!!!



If your child has long hair, please make sure it is pulled back into a ponytail for her gymnastics class. If you forget, we keep a supply of hair ties at the front desk.
